

SUMMARY

ASADA ATHLETE WHEREABOUTS POLICY

1. Required Athlete Whereabouts Information

- One location and one hour time period per day.

2. Provision of Information

To ASADA directly, using Athlete Whereabouts Online System, or by mail or fax (using a hard copy of the ASADA Athlete Whereabouts Form).

3. Failure to Provide Information (FTPI)

Athlete does not submit complete Athlete Whereabouts Information by due date = FTPI (one “strike”).

4. Missed Test

ASADA Doping Control Officer (DCO) attempts to locate athlete at nominated location for sample collection → Athlete not at nominated location → DCO attempts to contact athlete by phone → Athlete cannot be contacted, not in immediate vicinity or in immediate vicinity but unable to proceed to nominated location = Missed Test (one “strike”).

5. Anti-doping Rule violation (ADRV)

3 “strikes” within rolling 18 months = ADRV → Athlete’s name and details entered onto ASADA Register of Findings → Sanction.
